Each competitor must complete this form.

Submit your form and payment to your branch rep before the deadline

Entry Information:

- The COMPETITOR entry fee for 2019 is \$350.00 per competitor plus a \$5.00 number deposit that will be returned when you return your number. Total is \$355.00 for the 5-day competition and social activities.
- The entry fee includes food, billeting, social activities, commemorative gear and competition fees.
- The deadline for entries is May 15th, 2019. A late charge of \$50.00 will apply to entries received after May 15th, 2019.
- Entry fees will NOT be REFUNDED after June 5th, 2019 **WITHOUT A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE**
- Complete one Individual Entry form for each competitor.
- The Regional Tetrathlon Chair or committee must approve the members chosen to represent their Region at National competitions. Entry forms must be signed by the District Commissioner, Regional Tetrathlon Chair and by a Riding Instructor who has seen the proposed competitor(s) riding over fences. Only applications sent in by the Regional Tetrathlon Chairperson will be accepted. Applications sent in by branches or individuals will not be accepted.

Qualification

As a guideline, competitors selected to a Regional Team should be capable of attaining a minimum of 3200 points at their Regional Championship or at a previous Regional Competition or Clinic in their current division. Please note that this is a guideline only and is not meant to exclude capable athletes.

Divisions

Divisions are determined by the competitor's gender (**Men, Women**) and age as of January 1, 2019. Competitors may compete in any age division above their own. A participant may not switch divisions during the course of the competition. IF A COMPETITOR WANTS TO RIDE in a lower division, they may do so, but they will be penalized 250 points per phase ridden at a lower height and the competitor cannot place higher than other competitors that ride at the appropriate height for their division.



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National Tetrathlon Competitor Division:

Age as of January 1, 2019

12 – 14 years old

Division

Junior (JM, JW) D2 level riding competently at a minimum of the E.C. Entry level with a maximum fence height of up to 0.85m (2'9"). Run is 2km; swim is 200m; shoot is 20 shots single-handed.

15 – 24 years old

Senior (SM, SW) C level riding competently at the E.C Training level with a maximum height of up to 1m (3'3"). Run is 2km; swim is 200m; shoot is 20 shots single-handed.

All Qualified Athletes are Welcome

All tetrathletes will register as individuals. Do not worry if your Region cannot send a complete team. Because of low numbers of Pony Club members within Canada, ALL qualified tetrathletes will be accepted even if you are the only one in your Region. We hope to return to having so many members in the Canadian Pony Club, that a selection of a team from each Region will once again become a reality. Until then, we are encouraging ALL qualified junior and senior members to participate.
